Orphan's Court, Luzerne Co. PA, Court documents show that on 10 April 1820 Ann Telle petitioned the court to have Col. Edward Inman appointed guardian of Edward Tracy Telle and his brother Josiah Lewis. Edward was a minor under the age of 14. On 3 November 1823 John Espy, the brother of Ann Espy, was appointed guardian of Edwin Tracy Telle who is over 14, a minor son of Ambrose Telle, late of Wilkes-Barre.

Jim Reynolds' Papers said Edward's name was Edwin Tracy Telle. 1820 Orphan Court Records, the earliest known record of Edward, state his name to be Edward Tracy Telle, and three years later, Edwin Tracy Telle. Almost all the records during his adult life showed he was known as Edwin. Mr. Reynolds said Edward and Emaline were married in Mauch Chunk, Pennsylvania, but I could not find a record to verify that.

James Reynolds provided middle name and the place of William Frank Telle's death..

A letter by his cousin George W. Telle to Martha Telle in 1893 says Edwin lived in Indianapolis. In an 1894 letter from George to Martha, he wrote, "By the way you have resident in Salt Lake City, two Salem ladies, Mrs. Charles [or Charlene] Woods and Mrs. Ed Hopkins - [?] are here at present visiting their parents and expect to return to Salt Lake about the last of the month. The mother of these ladies is a relative by marriage of Uncles Edwin and Ambrose." This indicates that Harriett and Emaline, wives of Edwin and his brother Ambrose, are possibly related. A diligent search through Salem records could not confirm this.

An article in a Salem newspaper dated November 8, 1895, reported, "Edward Telle, who visited here a few months ago on his way to Indianapolis, went to Tampa, Florida, shortly after he was here and died [there] of consumption. His brother, Horace Telle, was with him. He was a son of Edward Telle, and the family lived for many years in Salem. . . . He was a printer by trade and had traveled all over the United States and some foreign countries." Horace was in New York City in 1893, "engaged when last heard from in office of New York World."

Frances Singleterry, a granddaughter of Omer's, stated Lillie's given name was Lillian, [although all records found indicated she went by Lillie]; her records showed John's birthdate was 20 April 1888 and he died as an infant; she provided Horace's death date and full birth dates of Ida, Agnes and Courtney, and death dates for Horace, Ida, Courtney, and Omer.

Frances Singleterry, a great-granddaughter of Elijah and Mary Hammond, had written information about him:

“Moved to Philadelphia and on May 15, 1806 married Mary Pollock. He was a merchant. In 1819 moved to Petersburg [Pike Co.] Indiana and bought a farm. He was County Judge for a number of years, active in Masonry and Shrine. He had 7 children. 1. Albert 2. Susanna 3. John

4. Perry C. 5. Lester 6. Jane 7. Aurelia. ---John Hammond born 1-24-1811 Petersburg, IN, farmer married Jane Stewart on 4-13-1843 and had 2 children. 1. John, Jr. and 2.
